- If you have friends who might be interested in adopting a Dane or Saint, bring them with you.

# **Adoption List**

As of May 20, 2003 we have placed 978 dogs in adoptive homes. There are, however, 34 Great Danes, 5 Mixes, 21 Saint Bernards, 2 Toy Manchester Terriers, 1 Toy Rat Terrier, and 3 Chihuahuas waiting for suitable homes. Please help us to find good homes for these loving and deserving dogs. All are spayed or neutered, heartworm tested, on heartworm preventative, have received all shots except rabies, have received medical treatment as needed, and have been temperament tested. A fenced yard is required to adopt a dog. Invisible or electric fences are not acceptable.

Adoption Fees: Purebreds (6 months and under)-\$250, (under 4 years)-\$200, (4 years and up)-\$100. Mixes (under 6 months)-\$140, (6 months and up)-\$100. Receive a 5 lb. bag of Science Diet dog food with each adoption.

## May 19 - 27


