## **COVID-19's Impact at the Rescue**

Along with the rest of Ohio, Harlequin Haven has felt the growing impact of COVID-19, and has made the difficult decision to temporarily close to support community-wide closures that encourage social distancing for containment of virus spread. We will however continue to accept and process applications while closed. All awareness events are canceled until May 1, when we will reevaluate.

The pandemic is affecting our dogs in other ways as well.

A surprising shortage we have encountered is in *canned green beans*. The green beans help supplement the meals of our chunkier dogs as we work to reach a healthy weight. We were having difficulty finding them as people began stocking up before the stay home order began, and supplies of them remain scarce.

Stores are also limiting the purchase of dog treats and premium food. Canned chicken and premium canned dog food added to kibble help entice our pickier dogs to eat. And although we have had to temporarily close to comply with the governor's order, our cleaning routines continue and cleaning supplies, like bleach and disinfectants, are also difficult to find.

If you HAVE, can FIND, or COULD donate any of the above items to the dogs of the Rescue it would really be appreciated. Like you, we are adjusting to a new routine during this stressful time and while the dogs at HHGDR miss their volunteers, they are enjoying the warming weather and longer days that spring brings.

Unlike us, they don't need toilet paper, they don't need paper towels, and they don't need gloves or masks. But if you can help, a donation of green beans, premium kibble or canned food, treats, disinfectant or a monetary donation would mean the world to them.

Thank you in advance for your understanding and support during this difficult time.

## **About the Rescue**

HHGDR has operated as a volunteer-run Rescue since 1992. It became a registered 501(c)3 nonprofit in 1998, and to date has placed nearly 1,600 dogs and horses in carefully screened forever homes. HHGDR serves Ohio, ex-

treme northern Kentucky, and parts of eastern Indiana. Currently 14 dogs and 1 horse are available for adoption. In addition, the Rescue houses Sanctuary Dogs living out their lives in the safe environment of the Rescue (the latter unadoptable for

health, age, or other conditions). In 2017, HHGDR spent more than \$20,700 on vet bills alone. Contributions are always welcome and are tax-deductible.

On the other hand, RIVA may have some misgivings... "Working from home has got to stop! My humans are driving me nuts!" Sounds like her family needs to check the list above.



Awareness events are held at festivals and pet supply stores. Volunteers set up with educational material provided by the Rescue and bring their dogs along. Passersby meet the successfully adopted dogs and hear about those that still need forever homes.

Volunteers also educate on the pet store/puppy mill connection and the need for spay/neuter of all pets.


