A. The directors and other knowledgeable volunteers who know the dogs and can match your lifestyle and family for several potential matches. Please read our adoption procedures.

Q. Why are you only open on Saturdays and Sundays?

A. Those are the only days that we can get enough volunteers every week-it takes a lot of people power to get the facilities and dogs ready, and conduct the adoption appointments.

About the Rescue

HHGDR has operated as a volunteer-run Rescue since 1992. It became a registered 501(c)3 nonprofit in 1998, and to date has placed 1,645 dogs and horses in carefully screened forever homes. HHGDR serves Ohio and extreme northern Kentucky. Currently 4 are available for adoption. In addition, the Rescue houses 9 Sanctuary Dogs living out their lives in the safe environment of the Rescue (the latter unadoptable for health, age, or other conditions).

In 2022, HHGDR spent more than \$23,000 on vet bills alone. Contributions are always welcome and are taxdeductible.
