About the Rescue

HHGDR has operated as a volunteer-run Rescue since 1992. It became a registered **501(c)3** nonprofit in 1998, and to date has placed **1,669** dogs and horses in carefully screened forever homes. HHGDR serves Ohio and extreme northern

Kentucky. Currently 6 are available for adoption. In addition, the Rescue houses 8 Sanctuary Dogs living out their lives in the safe environment of the Rescue (the latter unadoptable for health, age, or other conditions).

In 2024, HHGDR spent more than \$18,600 on vet bills alone. Contributions are always welcome and are tax-deductible.


